### SCRIP Fundraising

Scrip fundraising is a no-selling program that allows families to raise money for their non-profit organization (NPO). Scrip is just another way to pay for everyday purchases using gift cards in place of cash, checks, and credit cards. You purchase gift cards from your organization at face value, and your coordinator orders those cards from Great Lakes Scrip Center at a reduced price. The difference is an instant rebate for your organization. It's really that simple! Our ACS Scrip Coordinator will place an order every Friday. Expect the gift cards in approximately one week after order is placed. As the program gets up and running we will carry some gift cards in stock so that you may purchase them in the office. Orders are placed online, or through me, but will not be sent in until we have received your check. Checks can be turned in to the front office.
